Dear Parents and Carers,

Happy New Year! We hope you've all enjoyed the break. It's great to see the children settling back into their learning so well.

Overleaf you will find a theme overview for this first half of the Spring Term, detailing our learning objectives. Our theme is 'London's Burning' which will focus on a very famous event in our history; The Great Fire of London. We will link this to our PSHE topic around keeping safe and we're looking forward to a visit from the Fire Brigade safety team, later in the half term.

We will give spellings to all children on Mondays to practise during the week, and they will be tested on Fridays. Please encourage your child to practise often, every day if possible, to help them retain new words and spelling patterns.

Maths challenge books will be sent home every Friday. Please bring them back into school by the following Thursday.

One of the most effective ways you can support your child's learning is through their reading. Reading is so very important to children's learning and progress and we are keen to send reading books home with children. All children should have brought a reading book home. Please continue to hear your children read daily or read to them for 10 minutes. We ask that they read a book 3 times (unless reading longer, chapter books) before returning it for a new one. Children will also be able to access extra books through their Bugclub login, a copy of which should be in their reading record. During the year, we will be talking to the children about how to be successful and responsible readers in class. Read, read, read is our motto!
