Dear Families,

Keep the Children Safe

The Zig Zags outside our school are there to keep the children safe. **Please do not park on them!** On Thursday a coach with our Year 6 children on had no-where to park. This is not ok.

No Scootering or Cycling on the School Site

The reason we ask children not to cycle or scooter on the school site is because we have in excess of 400 children with all their families on site. We ask the children to walk their scooters and bikes to keep everyone safe and so that no accidents happen. Please re-iterate this to your child and support us when we do. Also please remember to leave school via the paths and not across the car park.

Classes

The teachers spend a lot of time getting the best mix of children in each class. Once the classes are set we cannot change them as each change has a knock-on effect on other children.

Year 6 SATs

We are delighted to announce our Provisional Year 6 SATs results.

Subject	Percentage of children achieving Age Related expectations at Queensgate	National Average of children achieving Age Related Expectations
Reading	78%	(+4% on National and +18% from last year)
Writing	69%	(-3% on National and +1.7% from last year)
Maths	76%	(+3% on National and +16% from last year)
Combined reading, writing and maths	60%	(-1% on National and +10.9% from last year)

It is also worth noting that;

36% of the Year 6 cohort also achieved greater depth in reading,

3% of the Year 6 cohort also achieved greater depth in writing

19% of the Year 6 cohort also achieved greater depth in maths

I am very proud of the Year 6 children and the staff who helped them achieve so well.


Year 6 Leaver’s Assembly and Clapping Corridor

Out & About

On Tuesday afternoon our **Year 5** Out and About group visited the Wight Aviation Museum at Sandown Airport. During the group's last session, they walked to the Highdown, Totland to see the testing site of the Black Knight and Black Arrow rockets. This week the children were able to learn more about space travel and the science behind rocket launching. They had fun taking part in their own (compressed air) rocket launches and were able to see the full size Black Arrow replica.



The children in **Year 4** are learning about Queen Victoria and her life on the Island. The Out and About team walked to Osborne House on Wednesday morning. They enjoyed exploring the gardens and visiting the house. The group showed great interest and curiosity when touring the house, confidently asking staff and volunteers questions to further develop their knowledge.

The **Summer Reading Challenge** is here! A fantastic, fun and **free** way to support your child's learning and pleasure, throughout the long summer break from school.

This year the national scheme is called "**Marvellous Makers**". The theme is creativity, craft, art, stories and poetry. It's **free** to join, and every child who joins gets a sticker collection poster. As they read books, they receive stickers for their collection and reward prizes. **When they've read six books, they get a medal and certificate.** Any child aged four to eleven can take part in the challenge. Younger brothers and sisters can join in, too, with a special **mini-challenge** sticker chart. (The prizes are not suitable for under 4s.)

Schools might ask children to show their medals or certificates after the holiday, to celebrate their achievement!
