Out & About

On Tuesday morning the **1KS** Out and About group hunted for a missing bear around the Old Barracks at Puckpool Park. The children found a note from the bear with clues to read and a trail to help find him. They were very enthusiastic and worked well as a team to read the instructions. After finding the bear, the children enjoyed a hot chocolate, story and play in the park.





All of **3PT** visited the Shipwreck Centre and Maritime Museum at Arreton Barns to conclude their learning on the Stone Age on Tuesday afternoon. The children learnt about maritime archaeology and the important role divers have in finding historic artefacts and evidence beneath the sea. They took part in activities around the museum; logging artefacts, making clay coracle boats, learning about dive equipment and finding out about Stone Age discoveries off the coast of the Isle of Wight.









On Wednesday morning the **4AH** Out and About team had a special Christmas themed session. The children visited Brook beach and were challenged to create their own 'Sandman Snowman'! They had great fun building (and naming) their sandmen (and ladies) using found resources on the beach as well as carrots for noses. There was lots of laughter when a passing dog stole a carrot nose from

someone's sandman. After our fun on the beach we visited Isle of Wight Pearl's Christmas Tree Festival. The children were impressed with all of the decorated trees but their favourite was the one covered in alpacas by West Wight Alpaca Farm.









The 2GC Out and About group visited the Wight Aviation Museum on Wednesday afternoon. The children were given a tour of the museum, learnt about different types of aircraft, the first propeller

and jet aeroplanes and the life of Mary Ellis. The children all had a go at making their own paper glider and racing them too. The staff and volunteers have been very welcoming each week and we hope to work alongside them again in the future.


