During the first Summer Half Term, the children would have been studying The Iron Man by Ted Hughes as the rich text to support their English work. We propose to continue with this and have added numerous resources to the school website to support your child with this work.

If you access the website <u>www.queensgateprimary.co.uk</u> you will find a rich variety of resources available to you to support your child's learning:

There is also an animated film version of the story available to watch which will further engage and stimulate your child's interest in the book. Please remember it is very important to set aside time each day for reading with your child. The Iron Man Challenge Cards and Guided Reading Activities would enable you to engage your child in a discussion about the book to deepen their understanding.

In Maths, we have added new resources to the school website with links to external websites and ideas to learn about maths in a practical manner (this will be updated regularly). Please encourage your child to continue practicing their times tables (both the multiplication and related division facts for the 2, 5, 10, 3, 4 & 8 Times tables which are the end of year expectations).









In science, we would have been learning about Light & Shadows in the first half of the Summer Term. We also propose to continue with this topic. We have attached a variety resources to the website for you to access and discuss with your child, together with links to external websites to support and deepen their learning.

For a fun learning idea, perhaps you could suggest to your child that they create a shadow puppet theatre and perform a show for you. We will be adding further resources to support this learning in the near future.
