Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome to Year 2! It has been lovely to meet all of the children and we are very impressed with how quickly they have settled back into school life and adapted to their new classrooms and teachers.

Overleaf you will find a theme overview for this first half of the Autumn Term, detailing our learning objectives. Our theme is 'My world' this half term. We have English and Maths lessons each day as well as daily phonics. We will also teach science each week and either History or Geography in each half term. In our PSHE lesson we will be thinking about Families & Friendships and Belonging to a community.

Our PE day this year is **Thursday** and children should arrive at school in their PE kit on this day please. In addition to this, your child may have PE as one of their PPA activities on Tuesday morning but they do NOT need kit on this day. PPA is on a Tuesday and *some* children will go on Out and About. The list for Out and About will be in the newsletter every Friday and you will receive a text if your child is in this group. Our PPA is led by Mrs Johnson, Mrs Hiscock, Mrs Cox and Mrs W. Webb. Your child may be doing DT, Computing, Music or going Out and About.

We will give spellings to all children on Mondays to practise during the week, and they will be tested on Fridays. Please encourage your child to practise often, every day if possible, to help them retain new words and spelling patterns.

Maths challenge books will be sent home every Friday. Please bring them back into school by the following Thursday.

One of the most effective ways you can support your child's learning is through their reading. Reading is so very important to children's learning and progress and we are keen to send reading books home with children. All children should have brought a reading book home. Please continue to hear your children read daily or read to them for 10 minutes. We ask that they read a book 3 times (unless reading longer, chapter books) before returning it for a new one. You will find ways to support your child with their reading in the front of their reading diaries. During the year we will be talking to the children about how to be successful and responsible readers in class. Read, read is our motto!

We would ask that all children have a book bag and *not* a rucksack as KS1 do not have the space to have them on their pegs. Book bags allow us to hand out letters and information far more easily. Children will also need a water bottle. They will have a fruit snack provided each morning. Thank you for your support, if you have any queries or would like to discuss your child's learning please contact the office and we will be happy to arrange an appointment. We are looking forward to a fun and successful year!
