Dear Parents and Carers,

This half term our main topic is the Romans. The topic overview is included with this letter outlining what your child will be learning, to enable you to support them at home.

We will be visiting Brading Roman Villa to support and enrich your child's learning about the Romans. 3PT will be visiting on 23rd June and 3BM on 24th June. (A letter about this trip was sent home in May, if you need a copy or did not receive yours, please contact your child's class teacher on the email address at the bottom of this letter)

As part of this half term's family homework we will be asking pupils to make a Roman building for a class display to be shared with you on the school website.

As before, Literacy homework and a numeracy challenge will be sent home weekly and a sheet containing 6 weeks of spellings to learn will be sent home shortly. Children who do not complete their homework at home are expected to complete it during their own time in school. Daily reading at home is still expected.

Year 3 pupils should be able to recall their 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 8 and 10 times tables by the end of year 3. We focus particularly on 3s, 4s and 8s, please practise these with your child.

Both 3PT and 3BM will have PE on Thursdays and both classes will have cricket lessons on Fridays. Please ensure that your child has an appropriate kit in school which includes trainers as most sessions will be outside. Sun cream and hats are also advised. Key Stage 2 Sports Day will (hopefully!) be on the morning of Thursday 1st July.

Our SEAL themes this term are 'Relationships' and 'Changes' and within these topics Year 3 children will be taught a series of lessons from the agreed Sex and Relationships Education, (SRE), programme. The children will be taught as a class group by their usual class teachers using educational materials which are age appropriate for Year 3 children. The materials include a DVD showing the similarities and differences between boys and girls and will focus on how we tell the difference.

During the sessions the children will learn some differences between male and female animals, describe some differences between boys and girls and understand that making a new life needs a male and a female. They will learn the correct anatomical names for body parts. Children will identify different types of touch that people like and do not like, begin to understand personal space and talk about ways of dealing with unwanted touch. They will learn that all families are different and have different family members and will identify who to go to for help and support. The information will be factual and the teachers will be sensitive in their teaching.
