

## Week SUM 2 WEEK 8 Home Schooling - English

English: 1] Keep reading, as often as you can.

2] Spelling rules and handwriting: just to remind you - choose 8 from the Year 5/6 (or Year 3/4) list and then in your best handwriting, put the words into sentences. Lists have been attached again.

TEST yourself or with a parent the year 5/6 spellings.....highlight those learnt.

You have 2 tasks:

**TASK 1 ; Book review. Choose either a text we have read in class or followed online in lockdown or a book you have read during the year, to review.**

Use one third of the attached paper to write your review, the smaller middle third for the book spine and author and the final third for the picture. Apart from telling everyone about the book, say why you enjoyed it and would recommend it to someone else.

**TASK 2; To write a letter to your new Year 6.**

**Draft** and then **write up/type** on best paper (attached), a letter to your new Year 6 teacher; either leave the letter in reception or email it to either 6LR or 6TS. Tell them a bit about yourself - family, pets, hobbies/interests.....just so they know a little about you for when you are back in September.

During the holidays, try and read as widely and as often as possible; keep rehearsing your spellings (and times tables) and do some handwriting. The idea here is that come September you are in the best possible place to both catch up and crack on with your learning.
