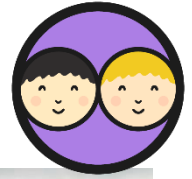


Sea

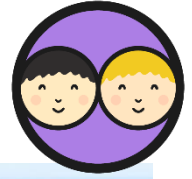


Pier

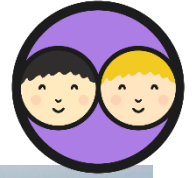

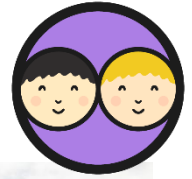

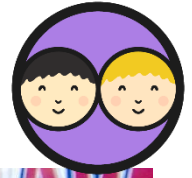

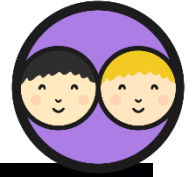

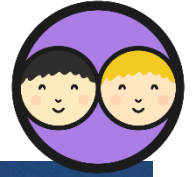

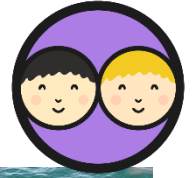


Lighthouse

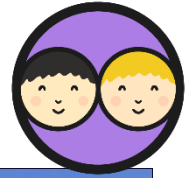
