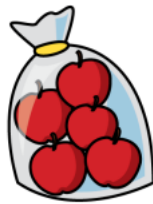


Maths Problems to Solve - wb 8th June 2020

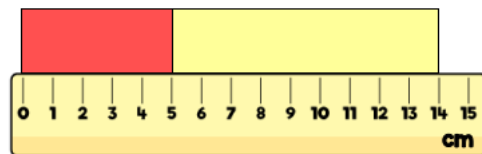
Monday
