# Monkey's Money Adventure: Wednesday

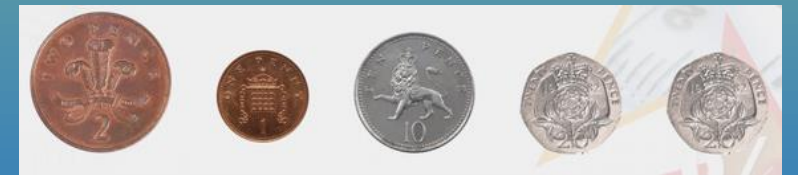
Today we are going to use what we have learned so far to find a total.

Using 2 different coins each time, how many totals can you make?



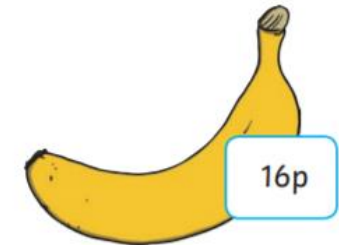
## What Coins Might She Get?



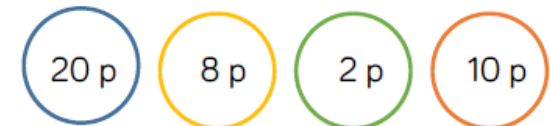
Jane buys a small toy for 15p. She pays with a 20p coin. What coins might she get for her change?

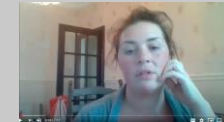

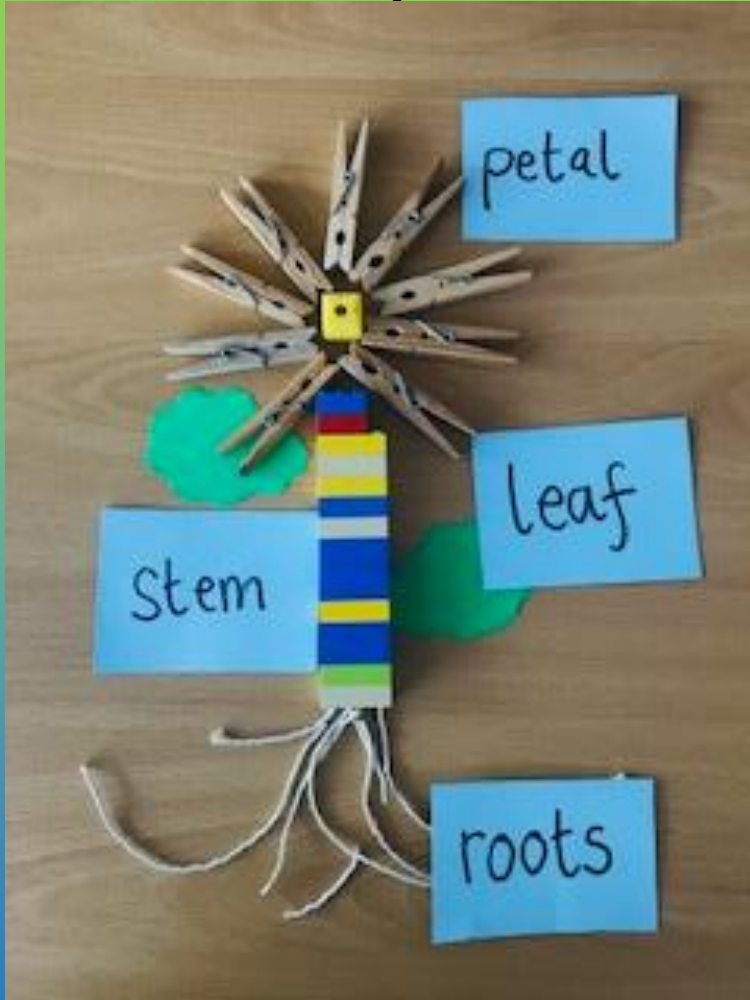
