Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back, we hope you have all had a lovely half term and are ready for the final half term in Year 5! It is a busy one with events such as sports days and two visits.

The first visit is on Friday July 1st to the Noel Turner Science and Technology Fair at CEC; see attached letter. The second one is on Friday July 15th to Robin Hill – a reminder letter will come out later on.

This half term our Topic is called Exploration and the overview is attached to this letter. We will be focusing on modern day explorers, such as Shackleton and Armstrong, and finding out about Space, the Solar System and different regions of the planet Earth.

Our class books this term will be Ice Trap! Shackleton's Incredible Expedition by Meredith Hooper, and One Giant Leap by Robert Burleigh. We will be using these semi-biographical texts to generate ideas for diary writing. Additionally, we will be creating space poetry with the aim of presenting and sharing.

Please continue to either hear your child read as often as possible or encourage them to read to themselves (five times a week would be ideal). All children should also be practising their times tables and spellings at home- it is essential that they know their times tables fluently before they start in Year 6-please test them and help them to practise.

The family homework for this half term is to write a biography of an explorer (other than Shackleton or Armstrong). It must include facts and details of the explorer's successes and failures. The homework must be in by Monday 11th July. This can be presented as a power point (bring in on a memory stick) or on paper.

This half term, Year 5 will be focusing on athletics, rounders and tri -golf in PE and Games. PE days remain the same 5RA on Monday and Wednesday, 5PG on Tuesday and Thursday. We hope to be outside for all of our PE lessons; sun-cream, hat and water bottle are advisable.

The PSHE unit of work for this half term continues to be relationships. As part of the scheme, we will be talking about sexual relationships in accordance with the national curriculum. If you have any questions about the content please ask a member of staff.
