Welcome back. We have all been excited with the move into the splendid new building. The children have settled in really quickly and soon found their bearings and understood the new systems (better than us!!).

This term our main sporting activity is swimming which will take place on a Tuesday afternoon, restarting on March 3rd. Same arrangements as before ie all children must bring swimming costumes, towels and goggles and swim hats (if they wish) all in a waterproof bag. Please label everything! The children are likely to arrive back to school at approximately 3:15 after swimming due to traffic implications.

Both classes will still require their PE kits to be in school at all times, 5PG will have indoor PE on a Monday and 5RA will have their PE on Thursdays.
