Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.</i></p>		
Week 1	Jack and the Beanstalk. Learn a story with actions. Story WHOOSH! Make a story map to sequence events.	<p>Science: Identify and label parts of plants.</p> <p>Art: Observational drawing of plants.</p> <p>Patch: Look for wild plants and flowers to sketch.</p>
Week 2	Jack and the Beanstalk. Focus on using adjectives in our writing. Create and describe own giant character. Describe a story setting. Life cycle of a dandelion.</p> <p>Patch: Use checklist to find and identify common wild plants.</p>
Week 3	Instructions - Magic beans. Focus on instructional language including imperative verbs and past tense (ed) ending words. Children will create their own magic beans seed packet.	<p>Science: Grow beans</p> <p>Art: Van Gogh, Painting-using water colours and poster paint.</p> <p>Patch:</p>
Week 4 (Bank Holiday)	The Wild Things	<p>Science: Identify parts of a tree.</p> <p>Art: Art talk-Van Gogh Sunflowers. Painting</p> <p>Patch: Wild Things Rumpus!</p>
Week 5	The Wild Things	<p>Science: Oak tree and animals that live in/ around it</p> <p>Art: Sewing into painting to add texture.</p> <p>Patch: Sketch trees</p>
Week 6	Oliver's Vegetables. Rhyme	<p>Science: How fruit and Veg grow</p> <p>Art: Evaluate art project.</p>
Week 7	Grammar catch-up Phonics screening.	<p>Science and History: Trip to Osborne House to observe plants, trees and Royal children's vegetable gardens.</p> <p>Design & Technology day: Fruits and Vegetables, design a healthy plate.</p>
