



Missing hands on the clock


- Draw the hands on the clocks for each time.
Remember that the hour hand is shorter than the minute hand.




10 o'clock




6 o'clock




7 o'clock

What you need to know At this stage your child is learning to understand and use words related to time. Your child will be **ordering familiar events** in time, learning the **days of the week** and the **months of the year** and will be reading the time to the **hour** (e.g. **4 o'clock**) or **half hour** (e.g. **half past 4**) on clock faces.
