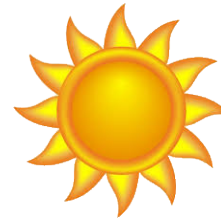

This week we will be looking at the weather.

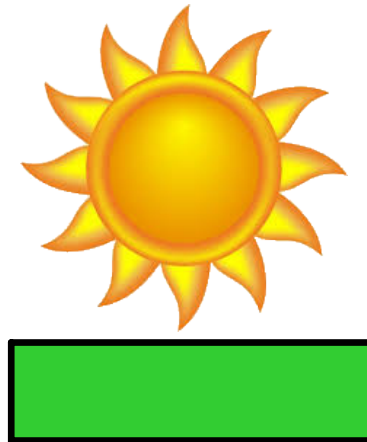
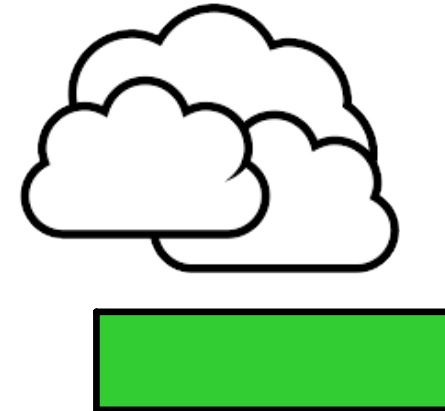
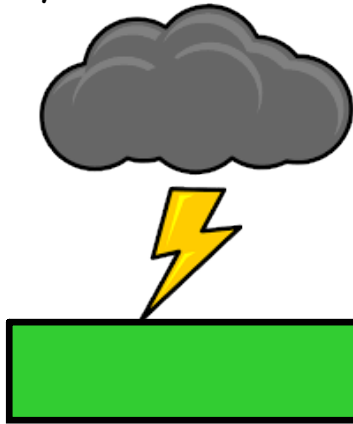
