Letters and Sounds

The next four letters are very short sounds, for example the g sound is "g" and not "g-uh". Please chat to a member of staff if you have any questions about Phonics. It would be great if you could upload a separate video for each sound. With your child please search at home for objects for the following sounds...



Please make sure that the object that your child chooses starts with the correct sound, for example the **g** sound is for words like goat and not giraffe! The **C** sound is for words like cat and not chocolate, the **ch** sound will come later in the year.
