

Writing based task –Week 3.

Seed Packets!

Task: Design/ make up a new type of plant and create a seed packet explaining what it is and write instructions that tell the gardener how to grow it.

These days you can grow all sorts of exciting and interesting things, such as...



Cucumelons- a tiny water melon looking fruit that tastes like a cucumber.



Rainbow roses- flowers that have petals of different colours.



Pineberries- fruits like strawberries that taste like pineapple.

Think about 2 fruits or vegetables you would like to be combined or how you might like a regular flower to look like something else or have a particular pattern.

Imagine what the fruit, vegetable or flower would look like and choose an appropriate name for it.

Think about how you would explain what it is to the gardeners who would buy the seeds.



Then write some clear, step-by-step instructions about how to plant and tend to the seeds so that they grow. Is there something strange that they need to be watered with? Do they prefer to be planted in a container other than a pot? Do you have to sing to them or recite the lyrics to 80's power ballads at them to make them grow properly? The more unusual the better!

As ever you could put your drawing skills to good use to illustrate your seed packet.
