Go on to David Walliams' website

<https://www.worldofdavidwalliams.com> and explore all of the things he has available. (There are some interesting sheets that link to some of his most popular books that might be fun to try.)

Listen to 'Elevenses' where David is reading out different chapters of his World's Worst Children books. Each chapter is about a horrible kid with nasty or annoying behaviour that means that they irritate everyone else! They always get into a tricky situation because of what they do or say and the consequences are generally quite funny!

Your writing task this week is to make up your own World's Worst Child and to write your own story about them. It could be based on one of the characters you have listened to or read about but you could change some aspects– or you might wish to start from scratch and create a brand new child with the most bothersome of behaviours.

Think about what it is that the child says or does that winds everyone else up. Do they do it on purpose? Are they aware of how annoying they are? What might they say or do? What are the consequences of their behaviour? Do they end up having to change their ways? What chaos is caused in the mean time?

I have attached a story that I wrote (based on my lovely dad!) in the style of David Walliam's World's Worst Children. Have a read to see if it gives you any pointers – trying to break a world record could be a good place to start!?

You might also want to design a few illustrations to go along with your story!
