I hope you and your child/children have enjoyed half term holiday and are ready for a busy half term leading up to Christmas.

Maths

In our maths lessons we will be continuing to develop our calculation skills, arithmetic skills and our fraction knowledge. It is important that all pupils continue to work on improving their times tables knowledge, the related division facts and the speed at which they can recall number bonds to 100. All pupils are expected to be doing 20 minutes per week on Prodigy or Timestables Rock Stars at home which will help them with their work in class.

English

This half term we will be studying the text King Kong by Anthony Browne. The main learning objective for this half term will be to learn a range of strategies to ensure that all writing is cohesive - both within paragraphs and between paragraphs. The children will also continue to develop and apply their knowledge of sentence structures and work on improving their vocabulary.

Topic

We will be continuing our South America topic by focusing on the Amazon Rainforest this half term. The children will learn why rainforests are important, the implications of logging and what life is like for the indigenous people living in the rainforest.

PE Lessons

We will continue to have PE lessons on a Monday and a Friday. Please make sure that your child has the correct PE kit in school on these days. As the weather gets colder, pupils are allowed to wear tracksuits rather than shorts for outdoor lessons.

Homework reminder

English and Maths homework will be set each Monday and needs to be completed by Friday.
