#### Google Classroom

We will be carrying out a survey soon to find out what access to the internet children have. Google Classroom is available as an APP so will work on smart phones and tablets, as well as laptops (especially Chromebooks). We won't be setting work that has to be printed, all work set should be available to do



online. Or it may be that the children do some written work, drawing, painting etc - this can be 'turned in' by taking a photo of the work and uploading it to Google Classroom. We certainly don't want to have loads of paper and printing as in the last lockdown, although we will obviously do this if a child doesn't have any access at all. Over the next few weeks Years 2 to 6 should be getting their log in details and some training within the classroom—the great thing about Google Classroom is that any work they do in school - they can pick up again at home.




