Happy New Year

Love reading?

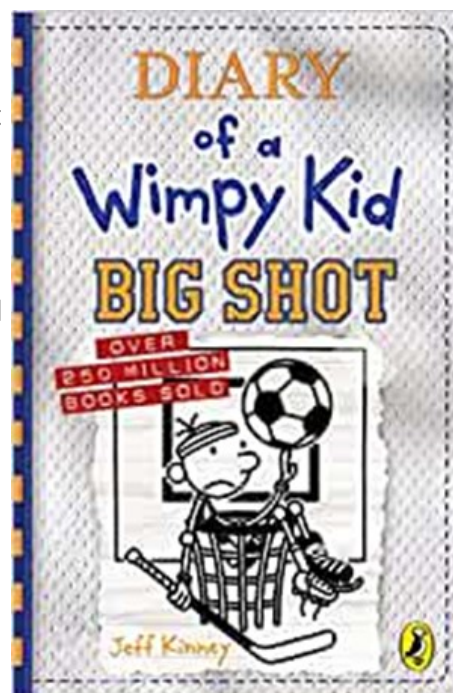
Then try this....
