
What Does a Doctor Do?

training, record things, work with and help other people and be good on the computer.







Doctors treat and care for their patients. Some doctors work in a local doctors' surgery as a GP - this is who you visit when you are not very well. Some are hospital doctors - this is who you see when it is an emergency, like when you have broken your leg. Doctors have to listen to what the patient says is wrong with them, look at them and may check their temperature and look in their mouth and ears. When the doctor treats the poorly person, they might give out medicine or tell them how they can get better. If they are really poorly, the

doctor sends them to a hospital doctor to help. Sometimes the doctor has to investigate and try different things to see what will make the person better. Doctors have to carry on learning new things all the time, go to meetings, record things, work with and help

other people, do lots of training and be good on





the computer. Sometimes, hospital doctors focus on one type of medicine or part of the body.


