Pupil Premium 2015 – 2016

Allocation £190, 000

Inclusion Team - £44,000 – 28% of children have identified SEND and 37% of children are in receipt of pupil premium. The Inclusion team manage and measure the impact of interventions to enhance opportunities and learning to ensure the gap between pupil premium children and others continues to close.

The Nurture Suite - £30,000 is spent on running the Nurture Suite. This is a facility to ensure children with behaviour or significant emotional needs are well catered for in terms of an amended curriculum and that other children are not disrupted in lessons.

Year 6 Closing the Gap - £16,000 was spent on specific targeted 1:1 and small group work in Year 6 in academic year 2014 – 2015.

Targeted Pupil Premium Intervention in Key Stage 2 - £45,000 is spent on two HLTAs to carry out specific targeted work in reading, writing and maths.

Early Support - £30,000 is spent on two extra TAs in EYFS to carry out targeted work to help support pupil premium children (and others) to reach a good level of development.

Speech Therapy - £10,000 is spent on in-house speech therapy due to the high level of need.

Educational Psychology - £7,500 for specialist advice to ensure all children achieve no matter what it takes.

Taxis - £600 to ensure vulnerable children attend school regularly.

School Trips - £3000 to support school trips and residential trips to ensure all children have equality of opportunity.

Swimming - £1,000 to support swimming for Year 3 and Year 5.

Uniform - £300.

Music Lessons - £600.

ICT Equipment - £2,000 to support learning including two laptops.
